### **ADMISSIONS**

Admissions in the 3 year & 5 year LL.B. courses shall be on the basis of an Entrance Examination, Haveli Law - Common Entrance Test (HL-CET) conducted by the college. Admissions will be purely on merit. The students qualifying the entrance examination will be eligible for admission, provided they fulfil the criteria of eligibility laid down by the University of Mumbai as well as Bar Council of India.

Students seeking admission into our college should apply online at www.mumoa.digitaluniversity.ac.in. While filling the online application form, students are required to furnish all the relevant information correctly.

Further, Admission Form & Prospectus can be obtained from the college office on payment of the requisite fees.

### About HL-CET (Haveli Law - Common Entrance Test)

Haveli Institute of Legal Studies & Research will be conducting HL-CET in order to shortlist aspirants for admission in both the courses. HL-CET application forms are available online at www.havelilegalinstitute.com and can also be procured offline from the college premises.

### Eligibility

Candidates desirous of taking admission should fulfil the following eligibility criteria.

### LL.B. (5 YEAR COURSE)

- Minimum 45% in aggregate at HSC (any stream) from a recognized board.
- 5% relaxation to SC, ST candidates.
- The candidates who have appeared for HSC examination and whose results are awaited are eligible for HL-CET subject to clearing the HSC exam with 45% in aggregate.

### LL.B. (3 YEAR COURSE)

- Minimum 45% at graduation level (any stream) in aggregate from UGC recognized university.
- 5% relaxation to SC, ST candidates.
- The candidates who have appeared for the final year exam of graduation and whose results are awaited are eligible for HL-CET subject to clearing the graduation exam with 45% in aggregate.

### **BACHELOR OF LAWS (5 YEAR COURSE)**

The five year integrated Law course leading to LL.B. degree is a 10 semester full time course. Performance of each of the student shall be evaluated by the internal and external examinations (following 75:25 pattern for new syllabus and 60:40 pattern for old syllabus) conducted at the end of each semester and also the performance in the practical training subjects as per the guidelines issued from time to time by the Bar Council of India as well as University of Mumbai.

### **BACHELOR OF LAWS (3 YEAR COURSE)**

Bachelor of Laws is an professional undergraduate Law Course. It is a 3 years Law course for those who missed the legal career opportunity after XII<sup>th</sup>. The teaching is conducted through the lecture method, practical and the class performances during the session. Internal and external examinations (following 75:25 pattern for new syllabus and 60:40 pattern for old syllabus) are conducted through written papers, practical and viva-voce.

### **CAREER ORIENTED DIPLOMA COURSES**

We at Haveli Institute of Legal Studies and Research, Silvassa, are delighted to offer three PG Diploma courses in the subject areas of Labour Laws and Labour welfare, Taxation Laws and Intellectual Property Law. These courses are of one year duration and have been conceived by expert faculties and with input from field experts. They have been designed and structured to address learning gaps in traditionally designed courses in these subject areas.

In addition, due to dynamic nature of these subjects, learning gaps have often been found in students and young professionals working in related fields. It is to address these challenges that the courses have been designed keeping in mind practical skills, exposure and mental temperament required to succeed in careers associated with these subjects.

Therefore we have endeavoured to incorporate expert lectures, deliberation and discussion, research projects and exposure visits for effective learning process of our students.

We are assured that our efforts will be well appreciated and these courses will contribute to the improvement in knowledge and skills of prospective students.

### **DURATION AND STRUCTURE**

The duration of the Post Graduate Diploma is one year with four subjects. At the end of academic year, the participants will take written examination for 100 marks including MCQ and short answers. 60 marks are for project submission and 40 marks for viva-voce will be allotted in 5th subject i.e practical training.

The passing marks are 45/100 in each subject & 50% aggregate. The maximum span period for clearing the exam is three years from the date of admission by availing a maximum of three chances to clear each paper.

### TIME COMMITMENT

Students enrolled in this course shall have to ensure 75% attendance in each subject. Each module will be taught in blended mode. The class timings for this P.G. Diploma will be from 4 PM to 6 PM on two days per week as per the timetable to be notified excluding Sundays.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

The applicant for admission to the Post-Graduate Diploma course shall be a Graduate Degree holder in any stream from any recognized University in India.

The PG Diploma course will follow an interdisciplinary approach. There is no restriction as to age, nationality, gender, employment status in the admission process.



### **SEAT AVAILABILITY**

Total number of seats are 50 in each course.

3.	From 21 <sup>st</sup> day upto 50 days after commencement of the academic term of the programme	30% of the total amount of fees
4.	From 51 <sup>st</sup> day upto 80 days after commencement of the academic term of the programme or September 30 <sup>th</sup> whichever is earlier	50% of the total amount of fees
5.	From October 1 <sup>st</sup> to October 31 <sup>st</sup>	60% of the total amount of fees
6.	After October 31 <sup>st</sup>	100% of the total amount of fee

WARNING: Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college premises and outside. Any student indulging in any such activity that may be construed as ragging, directly or indirectly will face severe action which could even lead to expulsion from the college.



### **COLLEGE DISCIPLINE**

The college attaches great importance to discipline and the same must be scrupulously observed by all students. Failure to comply with any of the rules, regulations or requirements notified from time to time will lead to strict disciplinary action.

- Students must always keep with them the Identity Card issued by the college. They must present it for
  inspection or verification whenever demanded by the college authority or security staff.
- Students should make use of the college library and they must not loiter in the college premises whenever they are free. Students must be in their class on time. Late comers may not be allowed to enter the classes.
- 75% attendance is compulsory for being eligible for appearing in semester examination. (As per Ordinance
  no. 0.6086 of University of Mumbai) each term in each course, failing which the college authorities may not
  allow the student to appear at the final examination.
- Use of mobile phones or ear phones is strictly prohibited in the class rooms.
- No student, except with written permission from the principal can bring their vehicles inside the college compound.
- No picnic, social excursions or tours etc. shall be arranged without the prior written permission of the Principal. If students join in any unofficial picnic or tours, the college shall not be responsible for the same.
- No association or organization is to be formed, no meetings shall be held, no person will be invited to address
  the students in the college without prior permission of the Principal.
- It is the responsibility of the students to check the notice board everyday with regards to the examination
  forms, time tables, admission procedure, results etc. College will not be responsible for the negligence of the
  students in performing their due diligence.
- Students should always remain decently dressed in all the occasions and regular classes of the college.
- Dress code (Black and White formals with blazers) should be observed every day.
- Insubordination, misconduct, abusive language or misbehaviour can lead to the dismissal of a student.
- Students joining the college shall observe all the rules & regulations of the college laid down from time to time.
- Matters not covered by existing rules will be at the discretion of the Principal.

### COLLEGE REGULATIONS

- All students are responsible to the Principal, the Head of Departments and members of the staff for their conduct in College premises. Insubordination, abusive language, misbehaviour or misconduct can lead to the dismissal of a student.
- Demonstration of any kind in the college is strictly prohibited.
- In case of sickness, a leave application shall be submitted to the respective HoD's addressing to the principal
  along with a medical certificate within two days of resuming the college. Fitness certificate at the time of
  resuming the college is essential
- All the receipts on account of the fines imposed on students for any cause whatsoever shall accrue to the Students' Aid Fund of the College.
- All students applying for bonafide certificates, character certificates, testimonials etc. and requiring the
  Principal's signature on any kind of document or application should first contact the office assistant in the
  College Office. No papers applications should be taken by the students directly to the Principal.
- Students must complete the semester to the satisfaction of the Principal failing which they may be debarred
  as per University Ordinance.


